# Resource changes

- New IJS pools
  - The new IJS pools are now in production
    - ATLASDATADISK will grow once some invasive maintenance on other IJS pools are done
- ATLAS tape in Oslo got misunderstood wrt capacity
  - We thought we had 5PB, but it was 3PB installed. A little bit of borrowed capacity was needed to make tape reclamation work.
- ATLAS tape pretty tight on space
- Anything new upcoming to meet 2023 pledges?



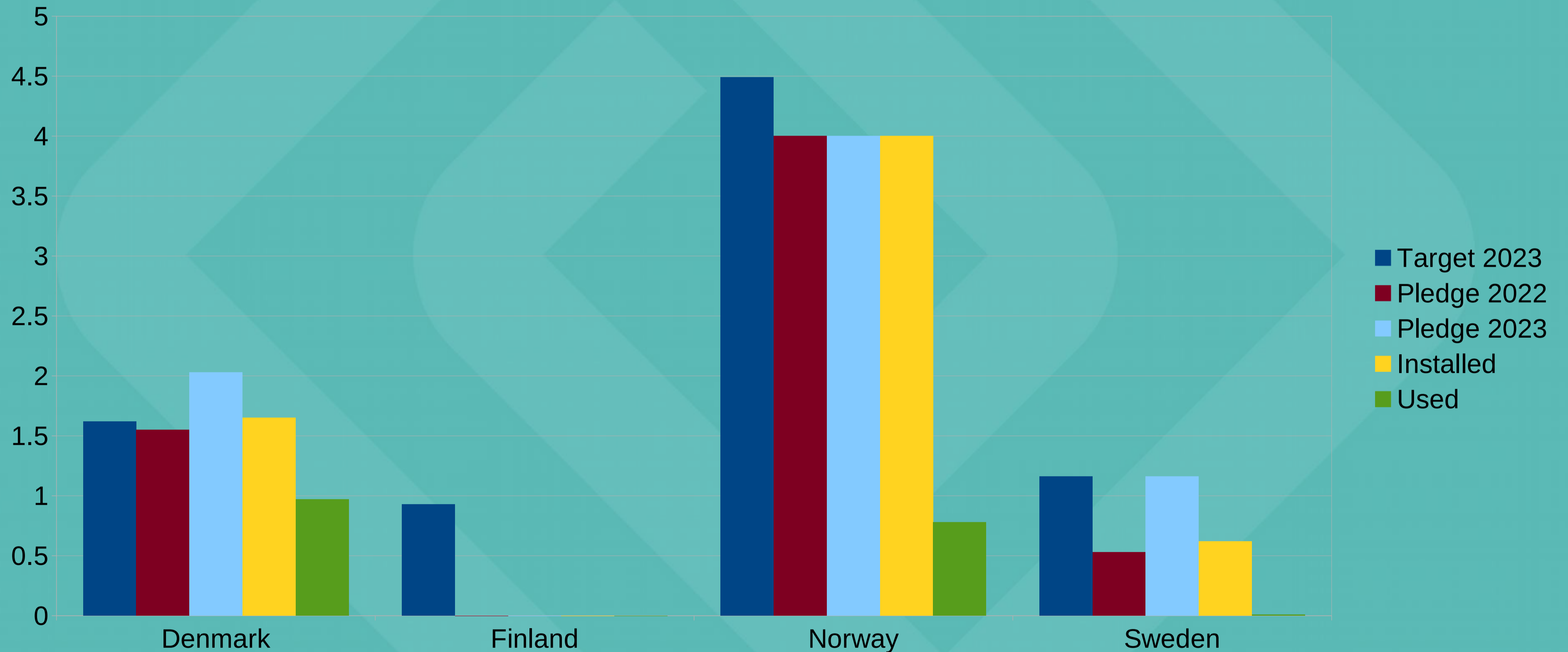


# Noteworthy events and issues

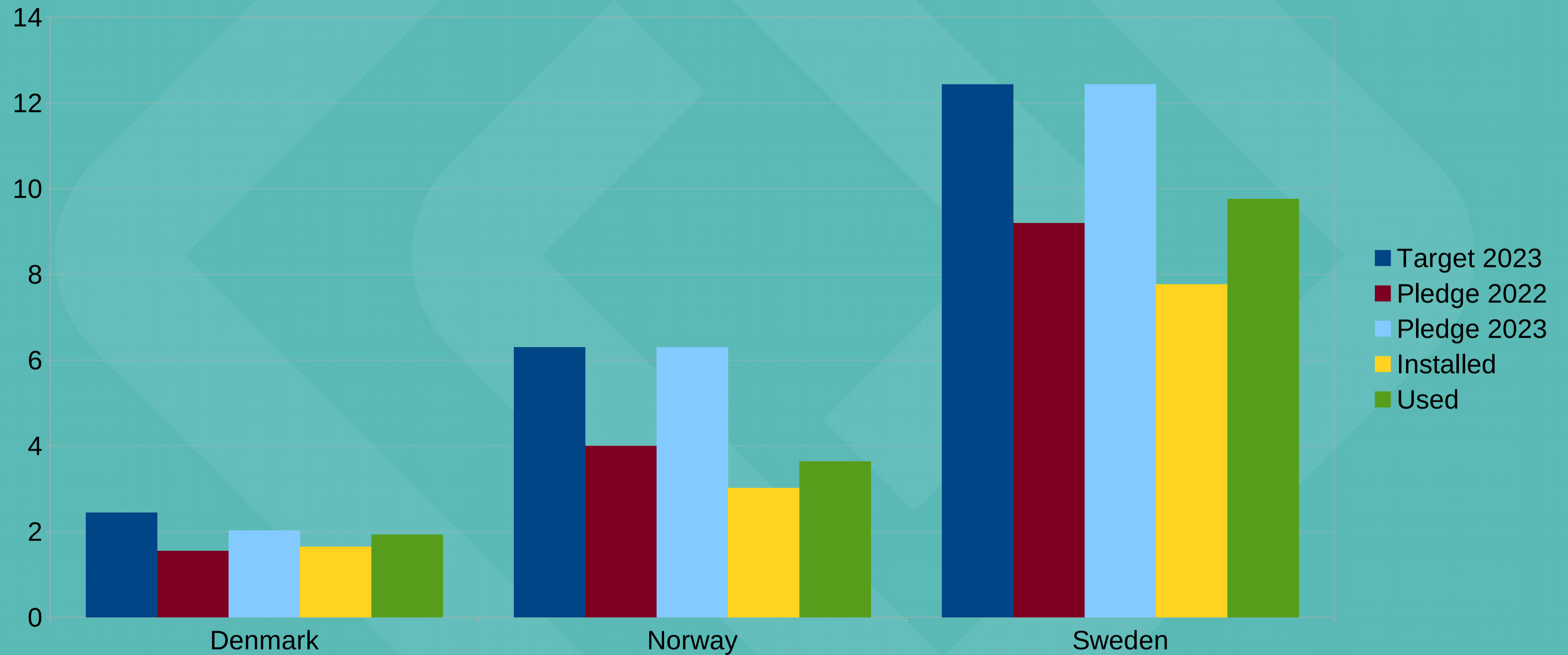
- Talk on Data Lakes Success Story regarding integration of tier-2 disk (and ARC caching) accepted for CHEP
- NeIC future as per the previous session
- HEPSPREC06 benchmark switching to HEPSCORE
  - In effect as of 1<sup>st</sup> of april, so new resources for 2023 pledges will be benchmarked in HEPSCORE
  - 1:1 mapping, so old resources can keep the same numbers
  - We plan to rebenchmark with the new code, so there might be minor differences in numbers



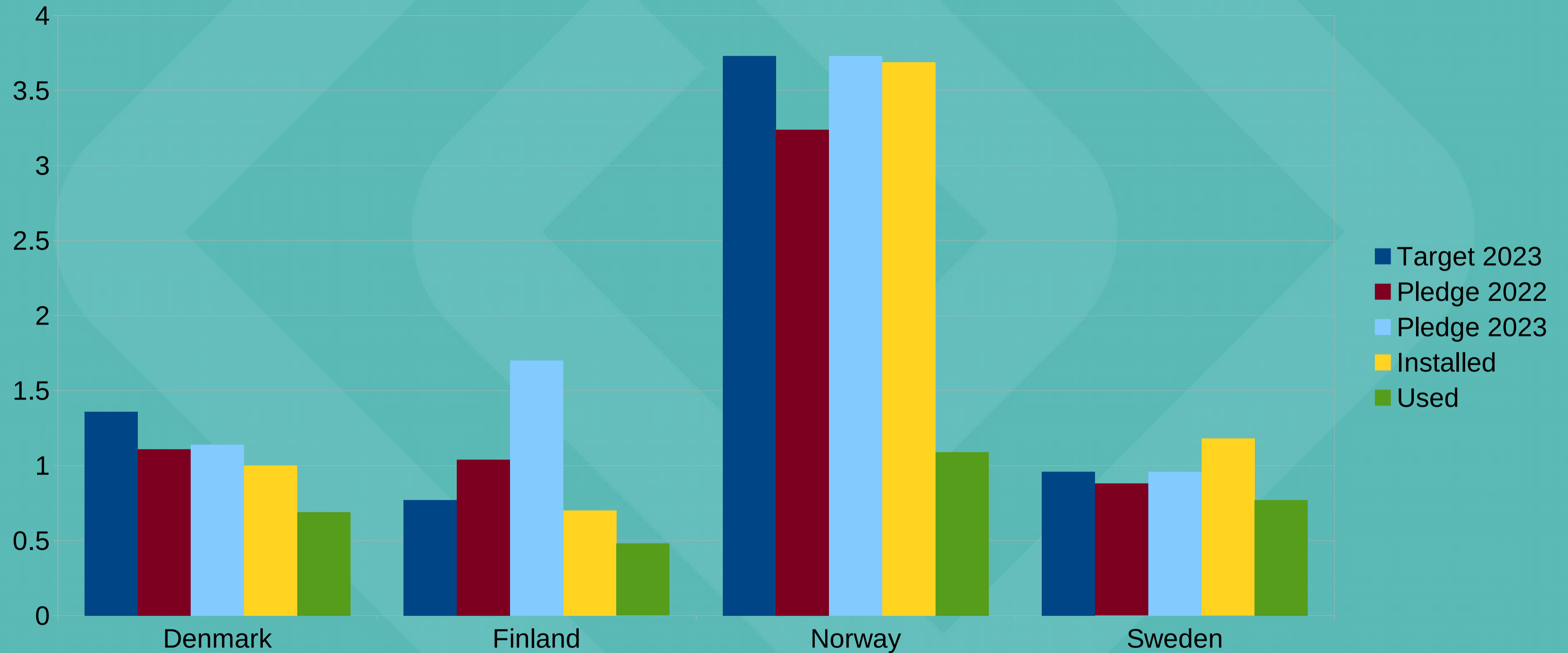

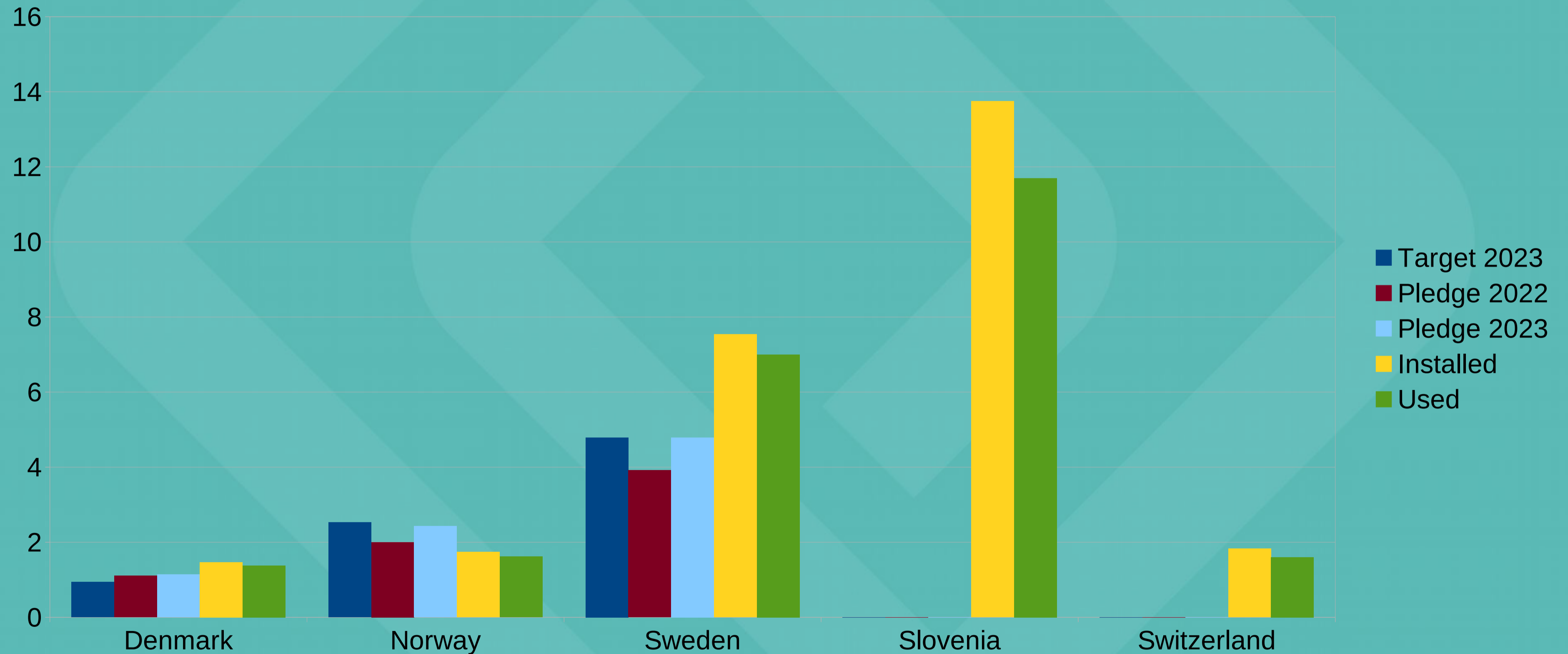
# ATLAS Tape

# ATLAS Disk



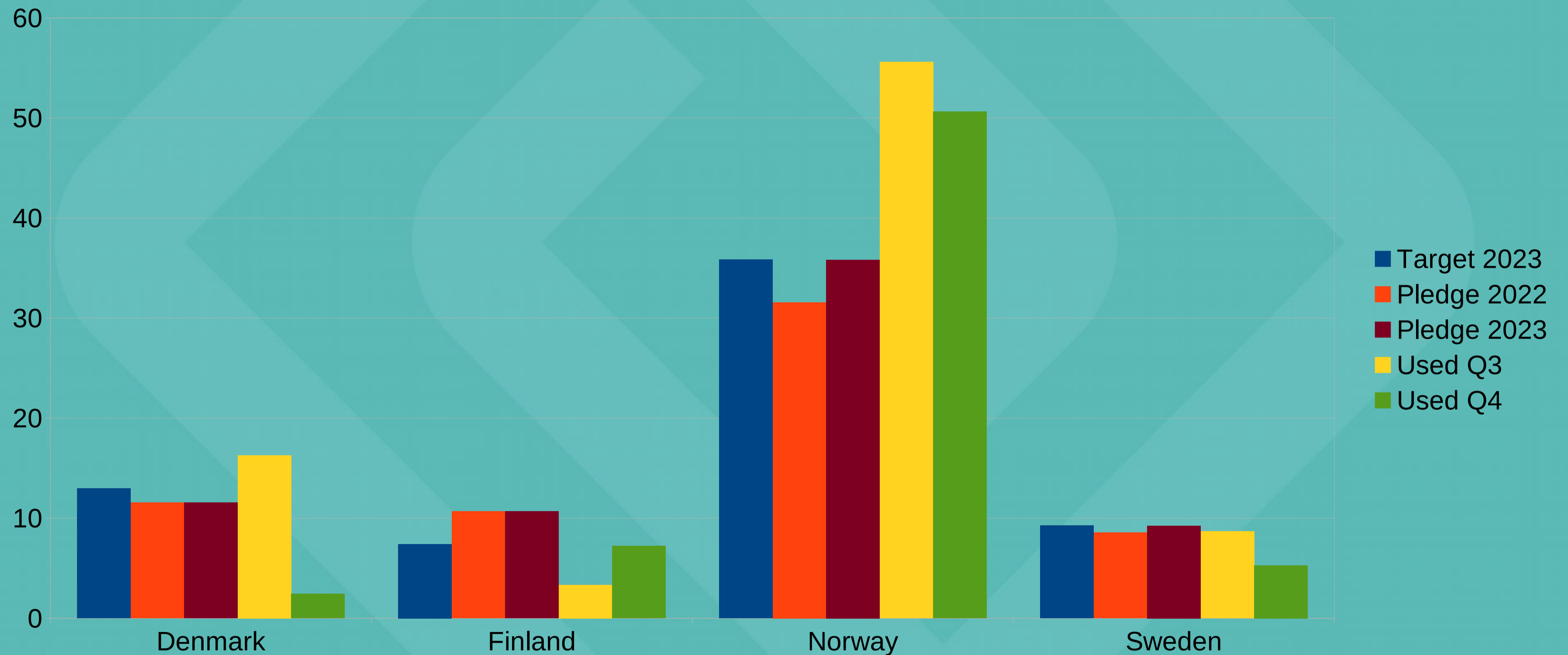


# CPU Usage Comments

  - Biggest gap in Copenhagen which only resumed running jobs this week – ATLAS happily took those empty job slots

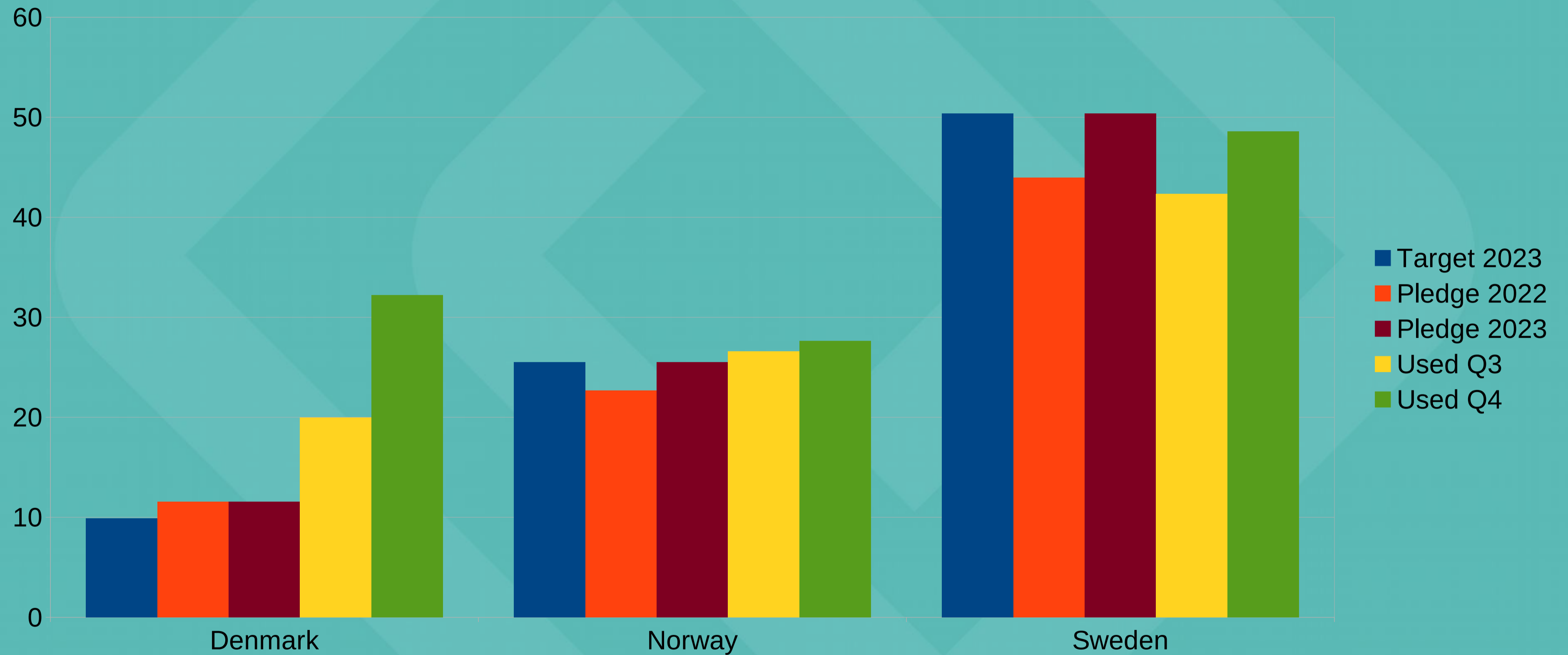


# ALICE CPU
