 - Tape can still be bought

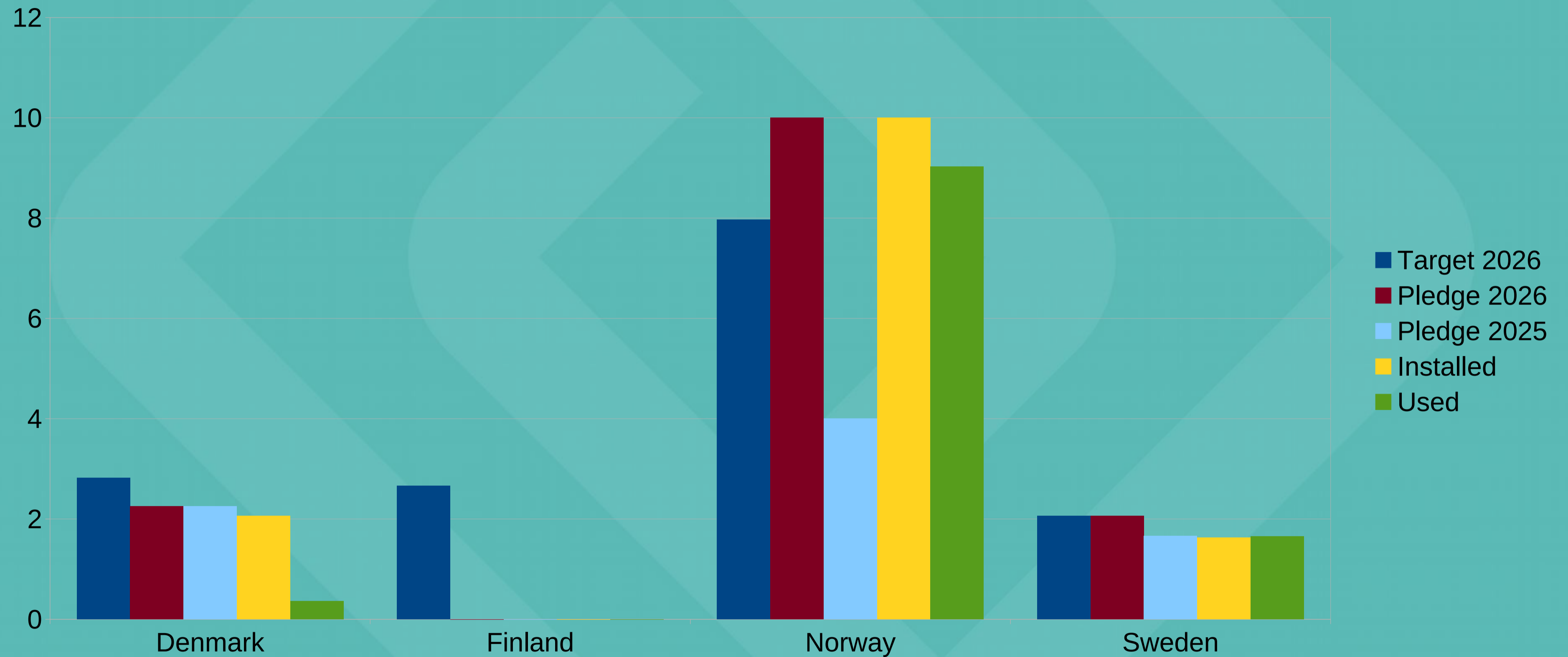


Resource changes

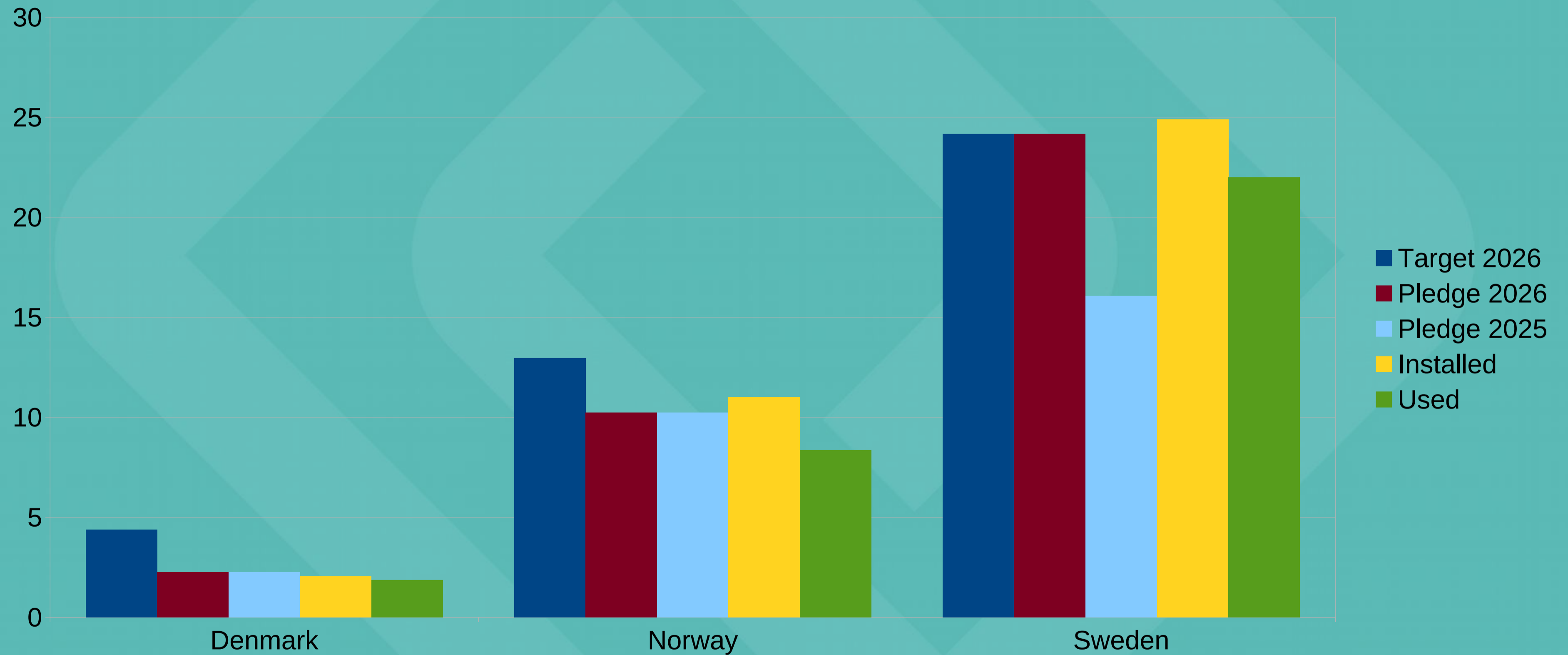
- Got notice that the current NBI disk should be evacuated due to being old and out of service

 - Still working on finding place for ATLAS data, not enough free space. Maybe we have to ask ATLAS about a reduction in space by some hundreds of TB.



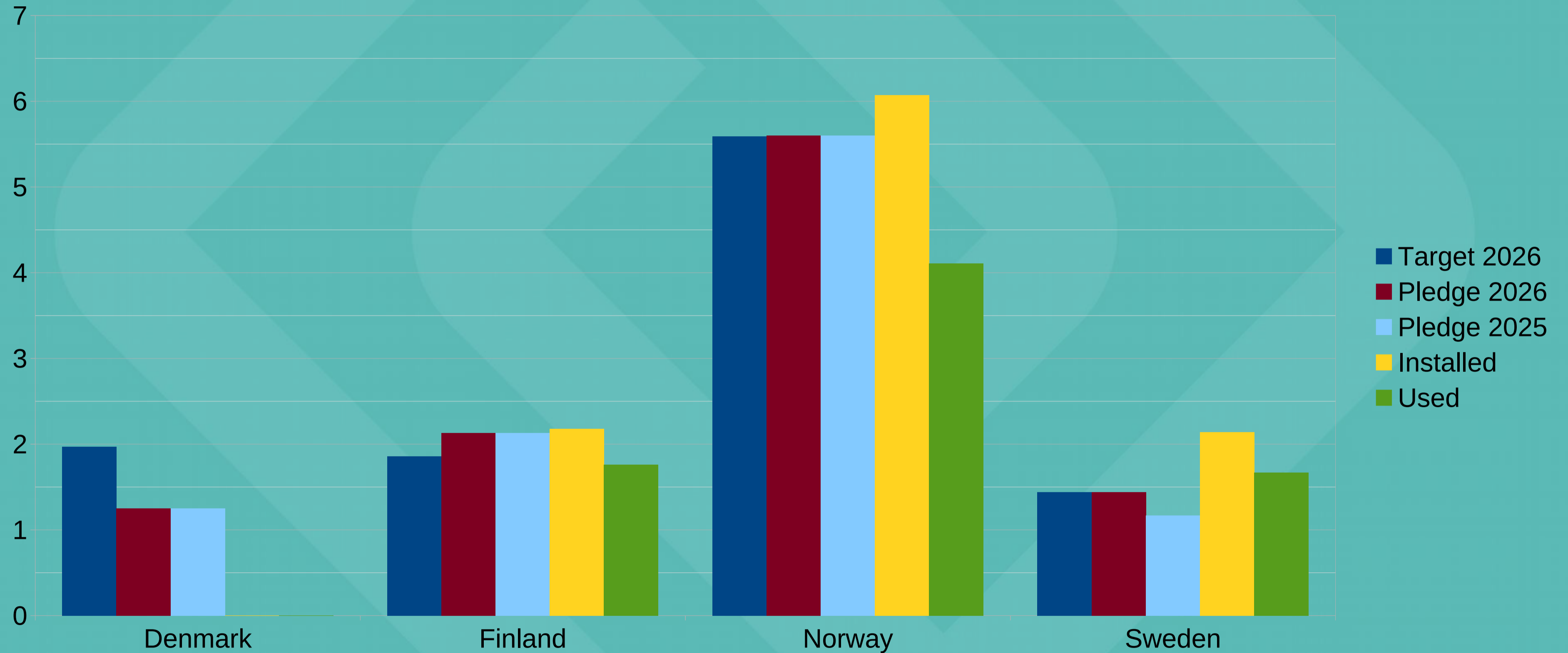
ALICE Tape



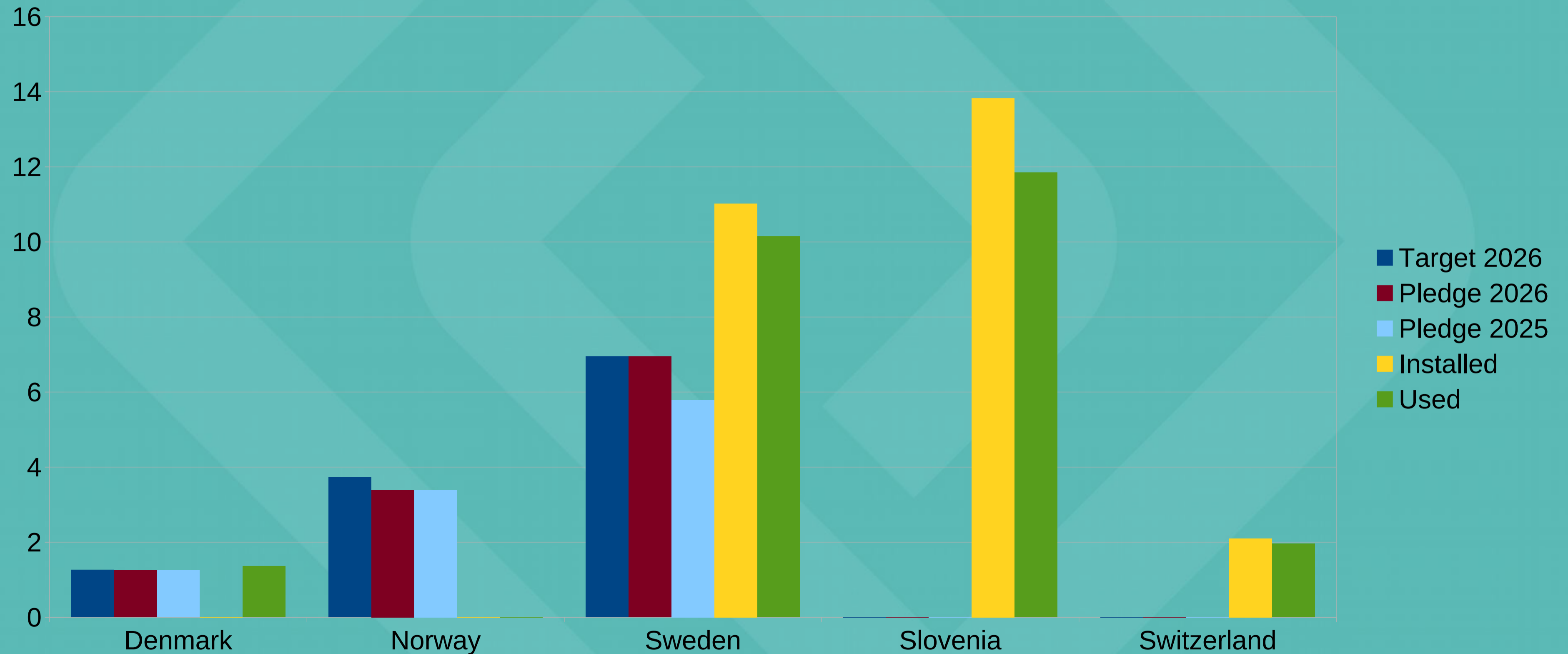
ATLAS Tape

ATLAS Disk

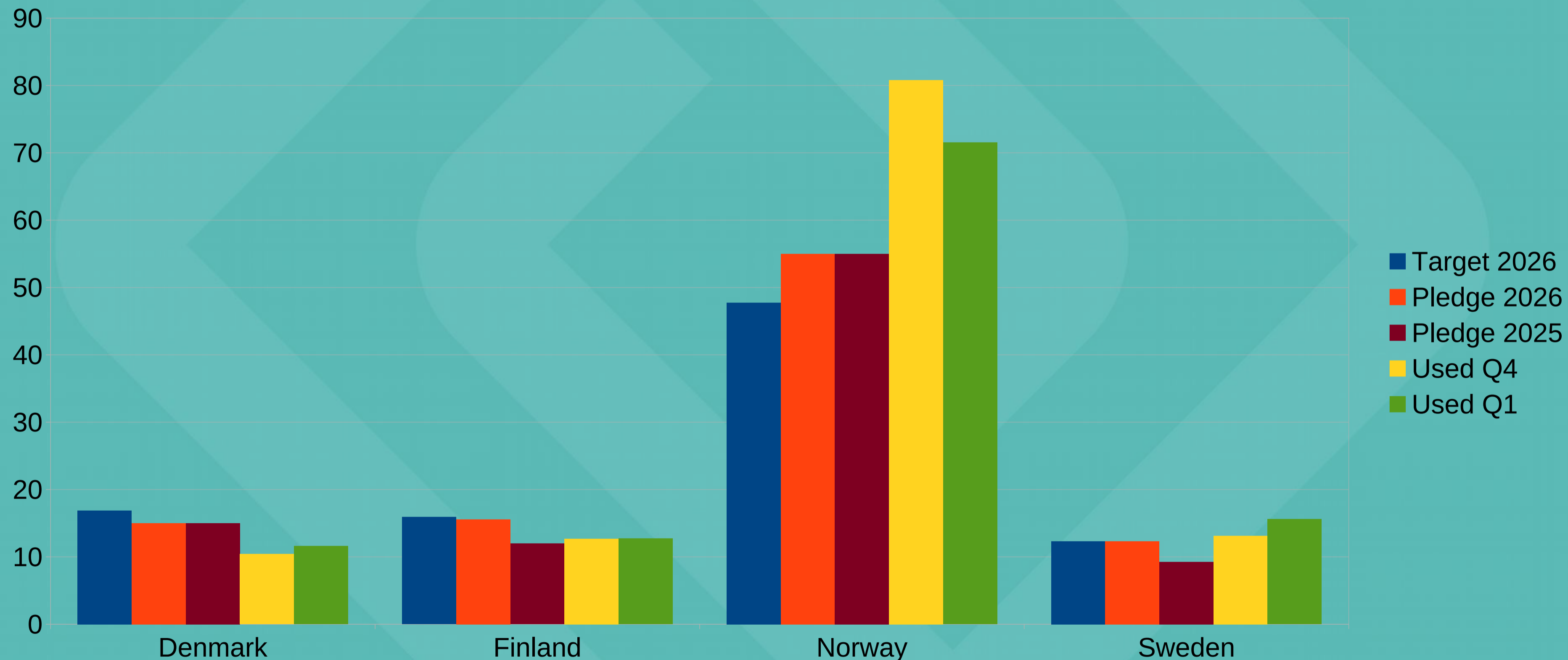


CPU Usage Comments

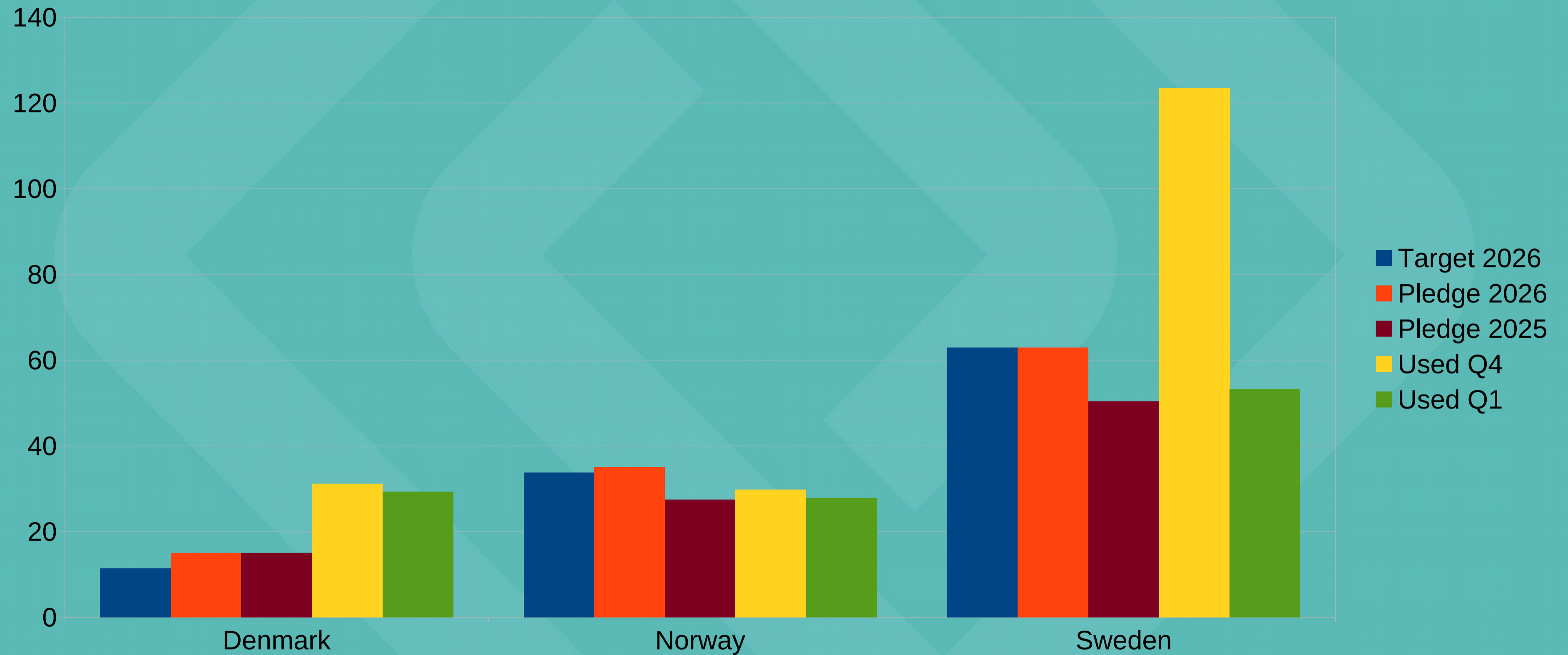
- Memory leak in ARC leading to reduced capacity on the biggest resources (especially HPC2N as biggest)
