

 Board within 2-day December Board meeting with strategy focus.


#### Impact and benefit analysis:

- benefit analysis: publications, datasets, workshops, consortia and networks, ...

2019. The travel grant will not continue. There will still be the last granted workshop within the Course mobility programme in January.

- We will also launch our training for trainers programme in 2019 with shadowing, pedagogical and presentations skills training possibilities for those interested in developing their training skills.
- We have organised two training BOFs this year: First on the 23.10 about current practises and customer training team member changes, and practical tips for making the course arrangements + web pages, and the second on the 15.11. about video training matters. We plan on continuing the BOFs next year.
- Our Virtual training team meets two times during autumn and two times in the spring.
- New NORDIC collaboration: Course/webinar of Video related services available in the Nordics and supported by NORDUnet, such as Zoom, Kaltura, and Adobe Connect: Erik Kikkenborg and national Video experts.
- We would like to benefit from the NEIC/RATATOSK collaboration and Carpentries membership by participating in the available trainings as well as contribute by organise a workshop if possible next year.
- Special development areas for next year: Al related trainings development and virtual learning management system for course delivery: Machine learning, deep learning, PRACE MOOC, Python for HPC with Future learn(Jussi Enkovaara, Martti Louhivuori)
